COLS & CPR at RST Cancer Hospital





On 7th November 2024, the Indian Medical Association (IMA) Nagpur in collaboration with RST Cancer Hospital, successfully organized a COLS (Compression Only Life Support) and few steps of BCLS (Basic Cardiac Life Support) training session. The event, held at RST Cancer Hospital, aimed to educate participants on the critical skills required to respond to cardiac arrest situations.

The COLS training program focused on the early recognition of cardiac arrest, prompt activation of emergency services, early chest compression, and rapid transfer to medical facilities. A key highlight of the training was its emphasis on continuous chest compressions, with a guideline specifically designed for laypersons to perform chest compression-only CPR, minimizing any interruptions in life-saving efforts and morbidity.

The hands-on training session was attended by over 250 paramedical and nursing students, providing them with practical knowledge and techniques.
