# A) AWARENESS RALLY

# B) CANCER AWARENESS SKIT

A skit highlighting the risk factors for cancer was performed by students from RST Cancer Hospital, Shri Ayurvedic College, and Tanishq College of Nursing. The event took place in the presence of over 350 spectators, effectively raising awareness about cancer prevention and healthy lifestyle choices."

# C) <u>FELICITATION OF CANCER SURVIVORS</u>

Felicitation of 5 Cancer Survivors was also done. They expressed their gratitude towards treating doctors and staff of RST Cancer Hospital.

Padmashree Awardee Dr. Vikas Mahatme informed about cervical cancer vaccine and requested girls to get vaccinated. He further said that Cervical cancer is one of the most preventable cancers, and vaccination plays a crucial role in its prevention. The HPV (Human Papillomavirus) vaccine protects against the high-risk strains of HPV responsible for the majority of cervical cancer cases.

Cervical cancer is largely preventable with HPV vaccination and regular screening. Increasing awareness and promoting vaccination, especially among adolescents, can significantly reduce cervical cancer cases worldwide.

Dr.Manjusha Giri, President IMA Nagpur addressed the gathering and said that "Prevention is better than cure". During adolescence, the frontal lobe is still immature, making individuals more susceptible to habit formation. Exposure to unhealthy behaviors such as smoking, alcohol abuse, and poor diet during this critical period significantly increases the risk of malignancies later in life, she added.

Recognizing this, we must prioritize adolescent-focused awareness programs. In this regard, she urged the dignitaries on the dais Mr. Nisar Tamboli (IPS), Jt. Commissioner of Police, Padmashree Awardee Dr. Vikas Mahatme, Former Member, Rajyasabha and Shri Sunil Kedar VP, Cancer Relief Society, RST and former MLA to act as facilitators in strengthening collaboration between IMA and schools, ensuring impactful health education and preventive initiatives
